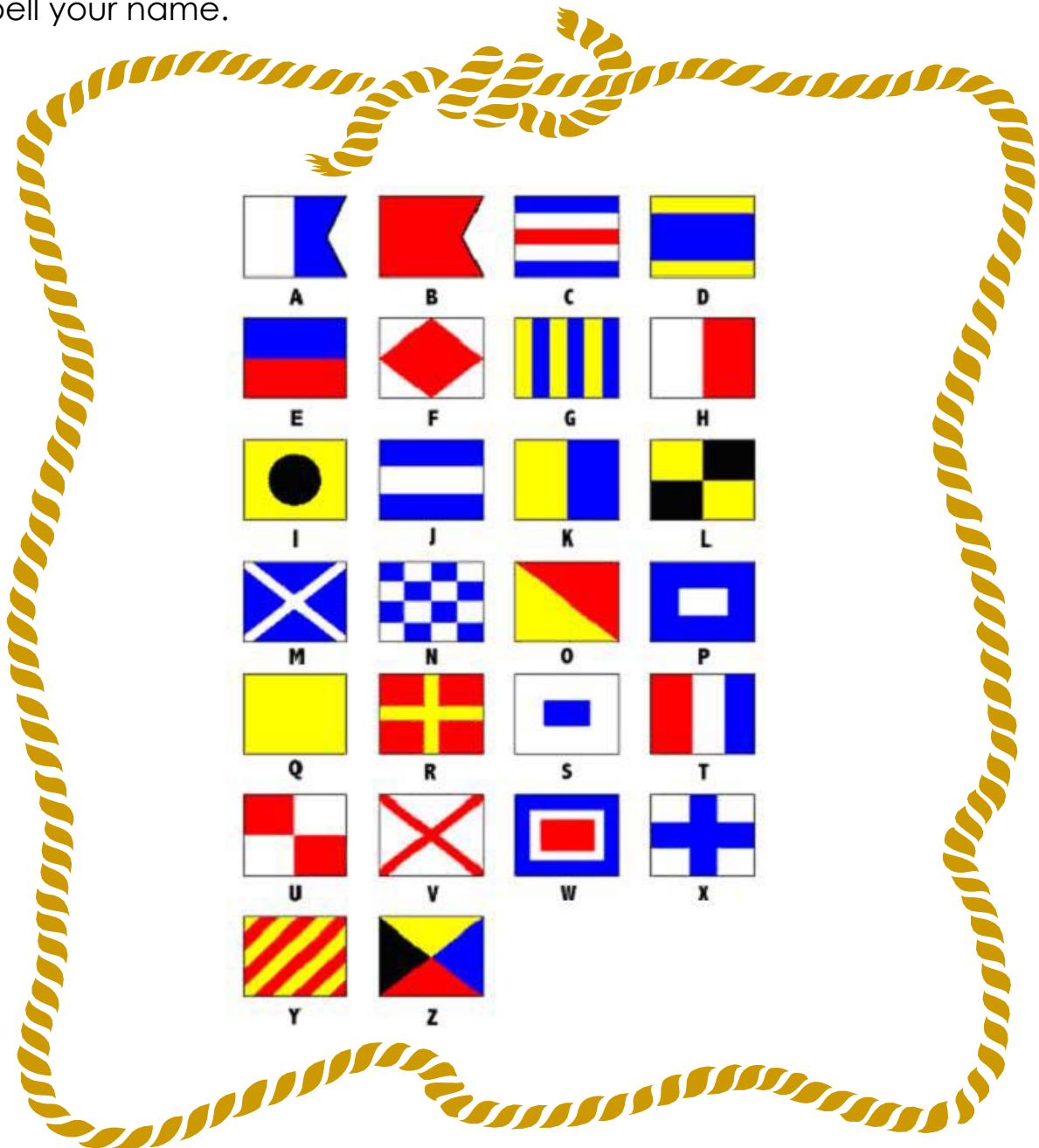


## Sea and Learn – Flag Your Name

Ships use a flag code as a way of communicating with other ships and to the shore. Nelson famously used a flag code during the Battle of Trafalgar.

Use the flags below to work out how you would spell your name using the International Code of Signals. When you have worked it out, draw the flags on another sheet of paper or card, colour them in and cut them out. Or you can colour in the blank flags included with this activity and cut them out instead. Once you have the flags ready, fasten them to a piece of string, or to a stick, in the correct order to spell your name.
